

DETAILED RULES REGARDING THE USE OF SYSTEMS RELATING TO THE  
DEPOSITORY AND BOOK-ENTRY TRANSFER SYSTEM FOR FOREIGN STOCK  
CERTIFICATES, ETC.

2010).

## Article 1 Purpose

These Detailed Rules provide for the necessary matters regarding the use of systems relating to the Depository and Book-Entry Transfer System for Foreign Stock Certificates, Etc. (hereinafter, the “JASDEC System”) at the Japan Securities Depository Center, Inc. (hereinafter, “JASDEC”) by the JASDEC Participants for Foreign Stock Certificates, Etc. (hereinafter, the “Users”) for the processing of the business of the Users concerning the Depository and Book-Entry Transfer Business for Foreign Stock Certificates, Etc. to be undertaken by JASDEC, pursuant to the provisions in Article 82 of the Business Regulations Relating to the Depository and Book-Entry Transfer of Foreign Stock Certificates, Etc. (hereinafter, the “Rules”).

## Article 2 Defined terms

1. In these Detailed Rules, the terms which are the same as the Rules, have the same meanings as in the Rules.
2. In these Detailed Rules, the terms set forth in the Items below shall have the defined terms set forth in such Items:

- (1) “User System” shall refer to the computer system for the Users.
- (2) “Integrated Web Terminal” shall refer to the computer terminal units for the use of integrated Web functions provided by JASDEC.
- (3) “Web Connection” shall refer to those methods of data exchange between the User System and the JASDEC System, which operate through the Integrated Web Terminal.
- (4) “File Transmission” shall refer to those methods of data exchange between the User System and the JASDEC System, which transmit data as files and as deemed appropriate by JASDEC.
- (5) “Online Real Time Connection” shall refer to a method of data exchange between the User System and the JASDEC System other than File Transmissions and as deemed appropriate by JASDEC.

## Article 3 Use of the JASDEC System by the Users

1. The Users, shall use the JASDEC System by way of exchanging data with JASDEC cited in each of the Items below for the processing of business concerning the Depository and Book-Entry Transfer of Foreign Stock Certificates, Etc.
  - (1) Web Connection
  - (2) File Transmission
  - (3) Online Real Time Connection
  - (4) Notifications or Submissions by electromagnetic medium which are prepared in accordance with the Detailed Rules.

2. JASDEC, when deemed necessary before the Users to start utilizing the JASDEC System, may conduct test in order for such Users to check if the appropriate JASDEC System can be used.

#### Article 4 Web Connection

1. The Users, when they make business processing by using the Web Connection, shall submit a prescribed notification to JASDEC.
2. Establishing circuit equipment for the Web Connection shall be undertaken by the Users in compliance with the provisions prescribed by JASDEC.

#### Article 5 Operation, etc., of Web Connection

1. The Users, in accordance with the provisions of the connection specifications and operation requirements, etc. provided by JASDEC, shall perform the operational processing by using the Web Connection, with the due care of a good manager.
2. The Users, when due to unavoidable causes a need for changes arises to the connection specification for the Web Connection and when there has been a request to that effect from JASDEC, shall respond to such requests in accordance with the instructions of JASDEC.
3. The Users, when trouble arises in the Web Connection, shall promptly contact JASDEC.

#### Article 6 Bearing of Expenses Relating to Web Connection

The Users shall bear terminal fee relating to their use of the Integrated Web Terminal (shall mean the expenses relating to the installation and maintenance of the Integrated Web Terminal), electricity charges and expenses for consumables, etc. as well as the expense relating to circuit equipment for the Web Connection (shall mean the circuit usage fee and share of the laying works costs. The same shall apply hereinafter).

#### Article 7 Circuit Connection

1. The Users, when connecting to a communication circuit (hereinafter, the “Circuit Connection”) relating to the File Transmission or the Online Real Time Connection (hereinafter, the “File Transmission, etc.”) between the User System and the JASDEC System, shall submit a prescribed notification to JASDEC.
2. The establishment of circuit equipment for the purpose of the Circuit Connection shall be done by the Users in accordance with the provisions provided by JASDEC.

#### Article 8 Operation, etc. of Circuit Connection

1. The Users, in accordance with the provisions of the connection specifications and operation requirements provided by JASDEC, shall perform the operational processing by the Circuit Connection, with the due care of a good manager.
2. The Users, when due to unavoidable causes a need for changes arises to the connection specifications of the Circuit Connection and when there has been a request to that effect from JASDEC, shall respond to such request in accordance with the instructions of JASDEC.
3. The Users, for any trouble that may arise in the Circuit Connection (including when a situation arises where data exchange by the File Transmission, etc. is not possible and the cause thereof is not clear), shall promptly contact JASDEC.

#### Article 9 Bearing of Expenses Relating to Circuit Connection

The expenses relating to the circuit equipment for the Circuit Connection shall be borne by the Users.

#### Article 10 Preparation, etc. of Electro-magnetic Medium

1. Preparation of electro-magnetic medium cited in Article 3, Paragraph 1, Item 4 shall be in accordance with the connection specifications provided by JASDEC.
2. In the case of the preceding paragraph, responsibility with respect to the preparation and submission of electro-magnetic medium shall be borne by the relevant Users.

#### Article 11 Procurement of Electro-Magnetic Medium

Electro-magnetic medium to be submitted by the Users to JASDEC shall be procured by the Users.

#### Article 12 Cooperation with Various Tests

1. The Users, when, by an advance notice given by JASDEC, they are required to participate in a linkage confirmation test between the Integrated Web Terminal and the JASDEC System or the User System and the JASDEC System via the Circuit Connection, shall cooperate with such test without protest. The same shall apply when participation in various tests other than the test described above is required by JASDEC.
2. Of the expenses required for the linkage confirmation test and the various tests provided in the preceding paragraph, the expenses of the User side shall be borne by the relevant Users.

#### Article 13 Confidentiality

1. Parties who are officers or employees or former officers or former employees of the Users shall not divulge any secrets obtained through the use of the JASDEC System to any third party.

2. The Users shall not disclose to a third party the JASDEC System specifications or use such specifications for its own business without consent of JASDEC.
3. The Users, when changes to the content of the notification submitted to JASDEC pursuant to these Rules are to arise, shall submit a notification to JASDEC in advance.

Article 14 Delegation, etc. of Processing of Business Relating to Use of the JASDEC System by the Users

1. The Users, when JASDEC permits, may delegate the processing of the business relating to the use of the JASDEC System to others.
2. Data exchanged between the computer system of the party to whom the Users delegated the processing of the business relating to the use of the JASDEC System pursuant to the provisions of the preceding paragraph (hereinafter, the “Computing Company, etc.”) and the JASDEC System shall be treated as data exchanged between the User System of the Users who delegated the processing of the business relating to the use of the JASDEC System to the Computing Company, etc. (hereinafter, the “Delegating Users”) and the JASDEC System.
3. The documents exchanged between the Computing Company, etc. and JASDEC shall be treated as the documents exchanged between the Delegating Users and JASDEC.
4. Accidents, etc. that arose in connection with the use of the JASDEC System by the Computing Company, etc. shall be resolved between the Delegating Users and the Computing Company, etc.
5. The Delegating Users shall cause the Computing Company, etc. to comply with the provisions of Article 5, Article 6, Article 8, Article 9, Article 10, Article 12 and Paragraphs 1 and 2 of the preceding Article.
6. The Delegating Users shall cause the Computing Company, etc. to comply with the necessary measures that JASDEC may take against the Computing Company, etc. in connection with the use of the JASDEC System.
