


1. Redesign with three concepts


- ◆ We have redesigned our website on the basis of the three concepts: "reliability", "convenience", and "familiarity".

2. Global navigation

- ◆ The new website provides global navigation at the bottom of the header. It is the same on every page and helps to move back and forth between pages smoothly.

4. Increase accessibility

- ◆ Web accessibility refers to the ease of access and use of information provided on the website, regardless of any differences in age or physical conditions such as the elderly or disabled, or in access environment such as devices and locations.
- ◆ Specifically, we've changed the design and colors to make it easier to read, and we've added text (compatible with text-to-speech software) to replace the images on the new website.
- ◆ Based on the spirit of "providing reliable, convenient and highly efficient services" as stated in our corporate philosophy, we aim to make our website "easy to understand" and "easy to use" for all people. As part of this aim, we strive to further improve web accessibility by complying with Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 Level A, an international guideline for web accessibility.
